CONCEPT

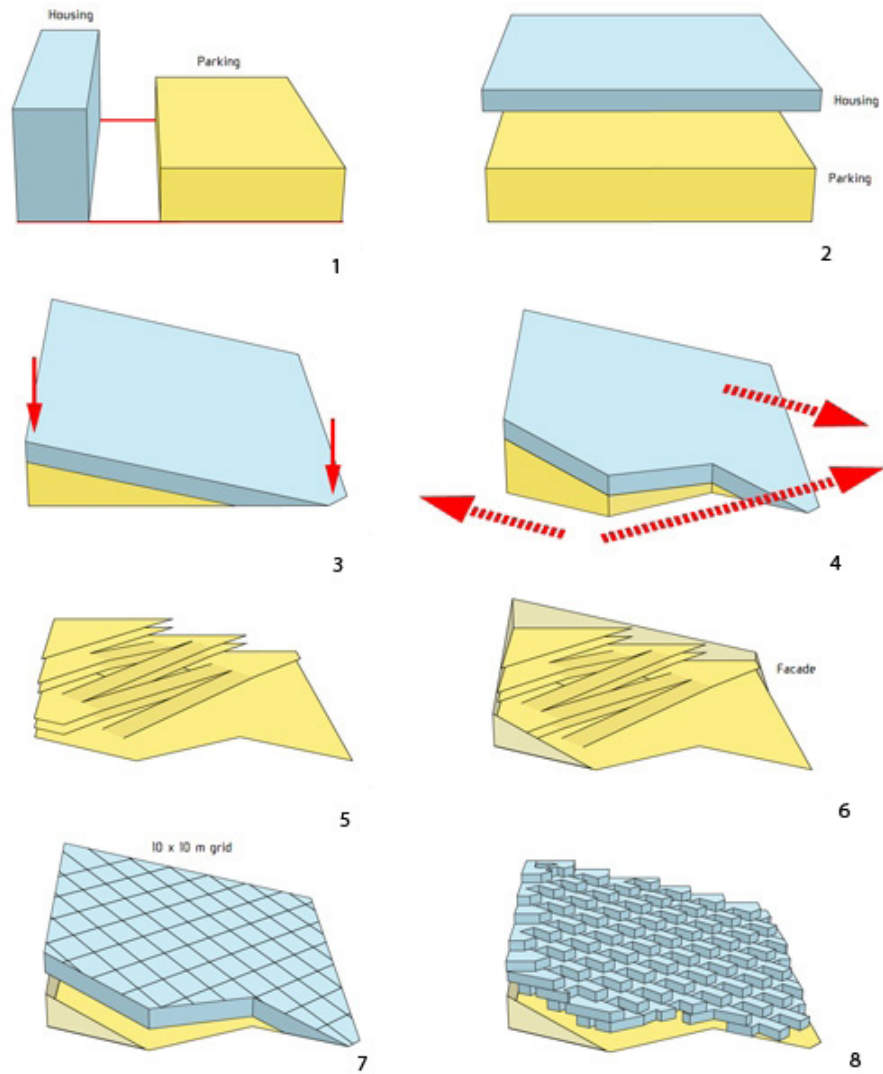
